Yellow-Fringed Orchid – <u>Platanthera ciliaris</u> (200 flowering plants noted)

Climbing Fern – <u>Lygodium</u> <u>palmatum</u>

-All three of these plant species were growing in association on a dry SW facing slope. The tree canopy was comprised of Pitch Pine, Virginia Pine, Sourwood, White Oak, and Chestnut Oak. Common understory shrubs included Vaccinium sp. and Mountain Laurel.

-Twenty individual flowering plants were observed on the road cut near the edge of the woods. The plants were magnificent and ranged from 4 to 6 feet in height.
